## SIGNATURE ARTIST STETSON HONYUMPTewa

Award-winning katsina doll carver Stetson Honyumptewa (Hopi) is this year's Signature Artist. Honyumptewa creates intricate dolls, many with modern messages in this traditional media. *Indian Country Today Media Network* notes that

"Honyumptewa's creative efforts often reflect the Hopi worldview by combining tradition, religion, and elements of children's stories."

Honyumptewa was born and raised in Lower Moenkopi (near Tuba City) on the Hopi reservation. He grew up learning Hopi cultural responsibilities including weaving and carving katsina dolls. Today he lives with his wife in Tesuque Pueblo and returns to Moenkopi to participate in ceremonies.

Honyumptewa was the **2010 Best of Show** winner at Santa Fe Indian Market and the **2012 Best of Show** winner at Heard Museum Guild Indian Fair & Market. He also has multiple katsinam featured in the Heard Museum's collection.
