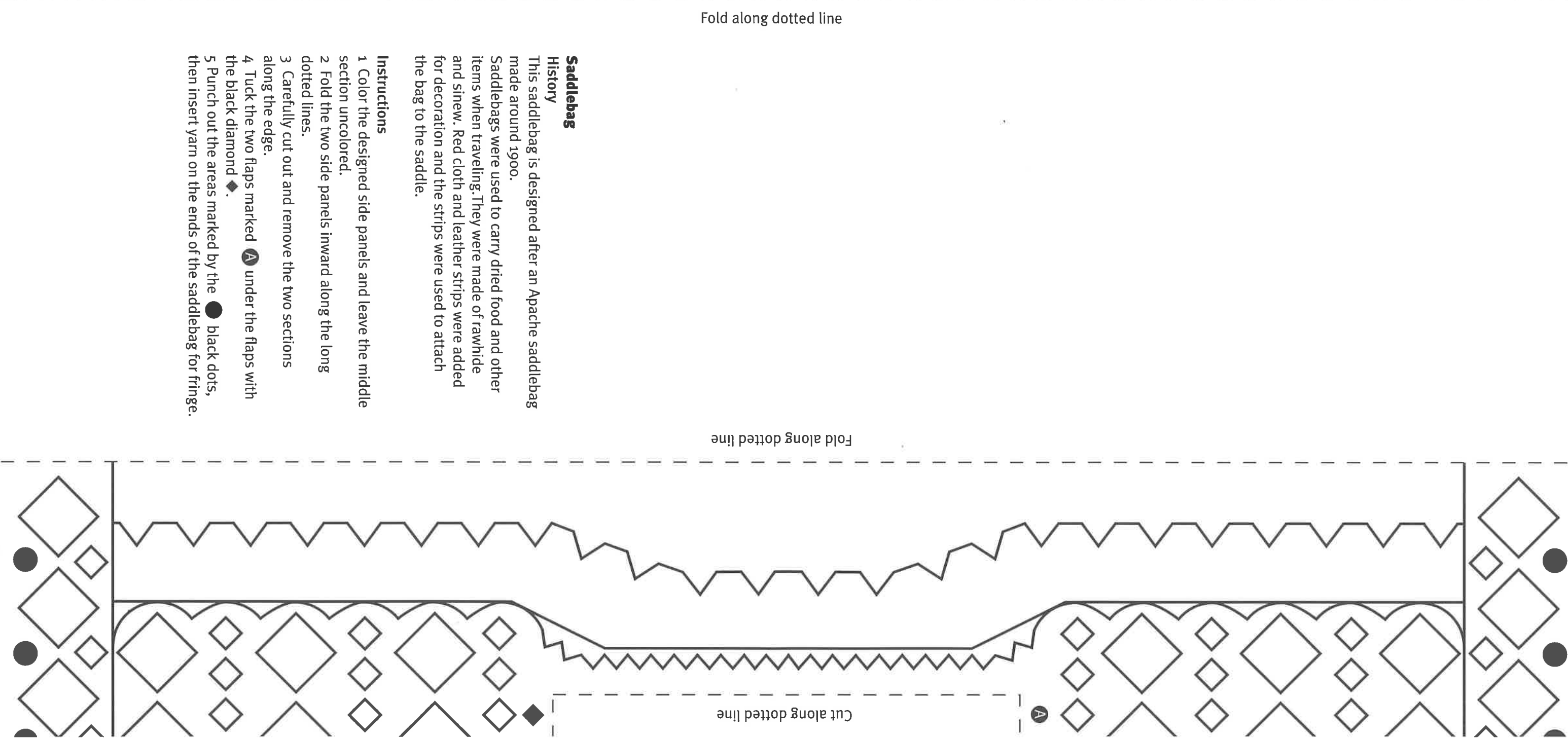


Fold along dotted line



Saddlebag

History

This saddlebag is designed after an Apache saddlebag made around 1900. Saddlebags were used to carry dried food and other items when traveling. They were made of rawhide and sinew. Red cloth and leather strips were added for decoration and the strips were used to attach the bag to the saddle.

Instructions

- 1 Color the designed side panels and leave the middle section uncolored.
- 2 Fold the two side panels inward along the long dotted lines.
- 3 Carefully cut out and remove the two sections along the edge.
- 4 Tuck the two flaps marked **A** under the flaps with the black diamond **◆**.
- 5 Punch out the areas marked by the **●** black dots, then insert yarn on the ends of the saddlebag for fringe.
