- The image files must be in JPG format and no larger than 2 MB (2,000 KB). Submit your images on a CD or DVD with this application. <u>Label the CD or DVD with your name and "IFM 2022."</u> You may also submit images by email to fair.artists@heard.org Include the same information about your artwork as requested below. Images will not be returned.
- The quality of the images you submit is critical: the better the images, the better your chance of being accepted into the Fair. Please contact us if you have any questions or concerns.
